COLEMAN HUTCHISON is an associate professor of English at The University of Texas at Austin, where he teaches courses in nineteenth-century U.S. literature and culture, bibliography and textual studies, and poetry and poetics. He is the author of *Apples and Ashes: Literature, Nationalism, and the Confederate States of America* (University of Georgia Press, 2012), the coauthor of *Writing About American Literature: A Guide for Students* (W. W. Norton, 2014), the editor of *A History of American Civil War Literature* (Cambridge University Press, 2015), and the co-editor of the *Cambridge Companion to the Literature of the American Civil War & Reconstruction* (Cambridge University Press, forthcoming 2022). Hutchison's research has been supported by the American Academy of Arts & Sciences, the American Antiquarian Society, the Bibliographical Society of America, the Boston Athenaeum, the Huntington Library, and the South Caroliniana Library. A past president of the Society for the Study of Southern Literature, he is at work on several projects, including the *Cambridge Introduction to the Literature of the American Civil War*, a collaborative book on close reading, and a cultural biography of "Dixie." In addition to a MA and PhD in English from Northwestern University, Hutchison earned a BS in education from Vanderbilt University. He has helped to develop a number of digital teaching tools, including a <u>"Song of Myself" audiotext</u>, the <u>Close Reading Interpretive Tool</u>, and the <u>Critical Reader's</u> <u>Toolkit</u>. In 2010, Hutchison received a UT System Regents' Outstanding Teaching Award and in 2015 a President's Associates Teaching Excellence Award.
